
What's new

Official start summary - Place des

- Location: Place des Voyageurs
- Gathering and live entertainment from 11:00 a.m.
- Official presentation of the sponsored children 11:30 a.m.
- Preparations for the official start 11:45 a.m.
 - 1 participant per team is admitted
 - Wearing a bib is compulsory
 - All disciplines combined
 - Position yourself in the Departure Preparation area * see map p.18
- Parade and non-competitive walk of honor

Equipment preparations for the official start

SKI

- Before the official start: Place your skis and poles on the ski rack near the gondola (a volunteer will guide you)
- Recommended you do the parade with espadrilles, but you are free to wear your ski boots:) it's up to you to determine the optimal strategy for your first tour

WALK AND RUN

 Locker room available in the walk and run transition zone to store your personal items after the first lap

ALPINE TOURING

- Before the official start: Place your skis and poles on the ski rack in the alpine touring transition zone
- We recommend you do the parade with espadrilles, but you are free to wear your ski boots:)
 - it's up to you to determine the optimal strategy for your first tour

First tour procedure

- 1 participant per team takes part in the starting parade;
- The starting participant must wear his bib and time chip;
- The parade will travel through rue des Remparts towards the base of the mountain;
- It is at the base of the mountain, at the entrance to your respective courses, that the sporting challenge will begin;
 - For the walkers, if other teammates wish to take the first lap with the participant who did the parade, this is where you can join them;
- Walk-run: the cabriolet is an integral part of the course, up and down, even if you do more than one lap during your relay.


