However, the weather forecasts are favorable for snowmaking in the coming days, which will allow us to open more skiable terrain and organize a great 24-hour event.

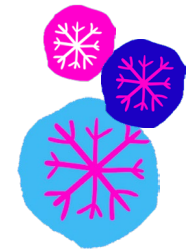
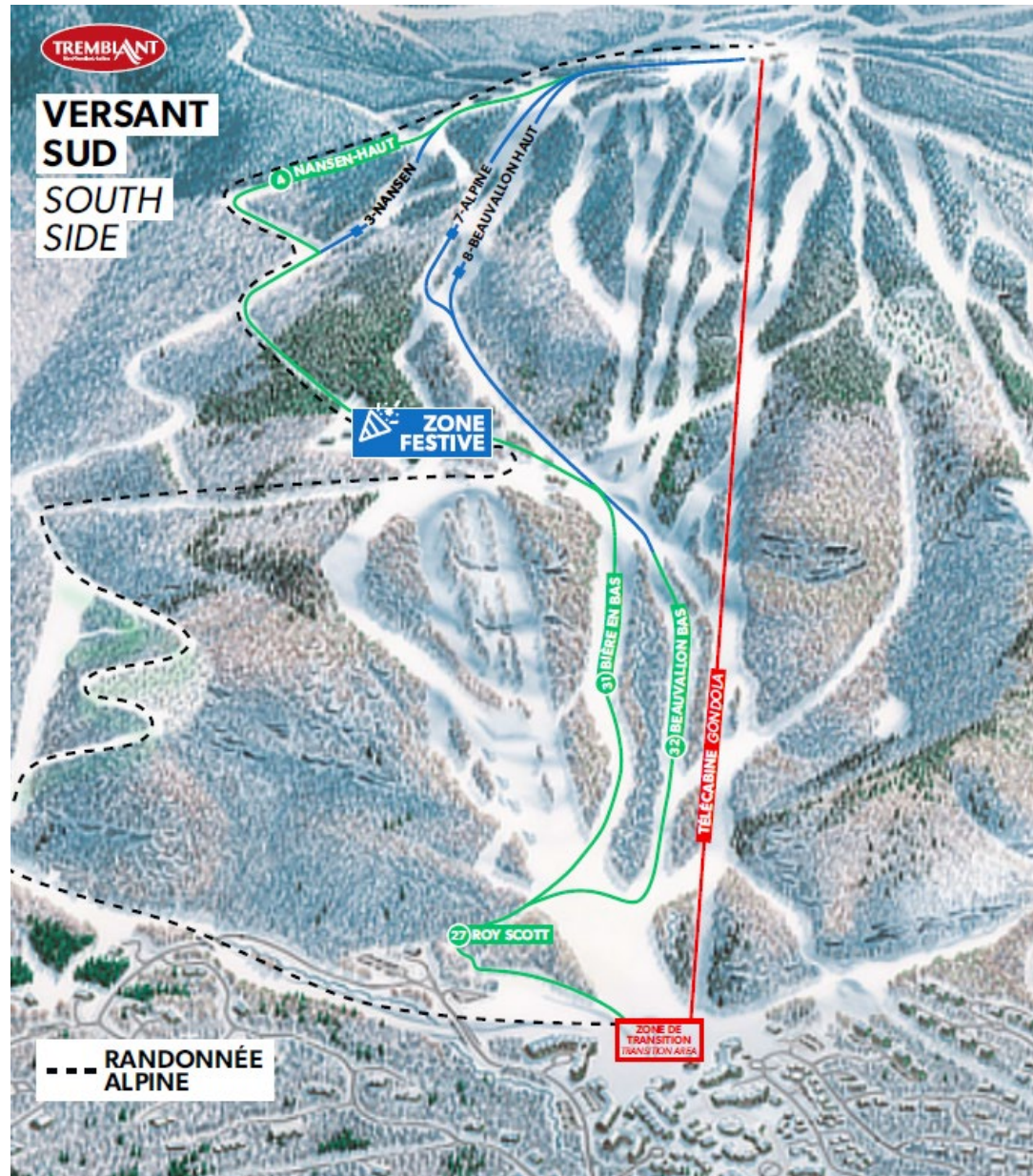

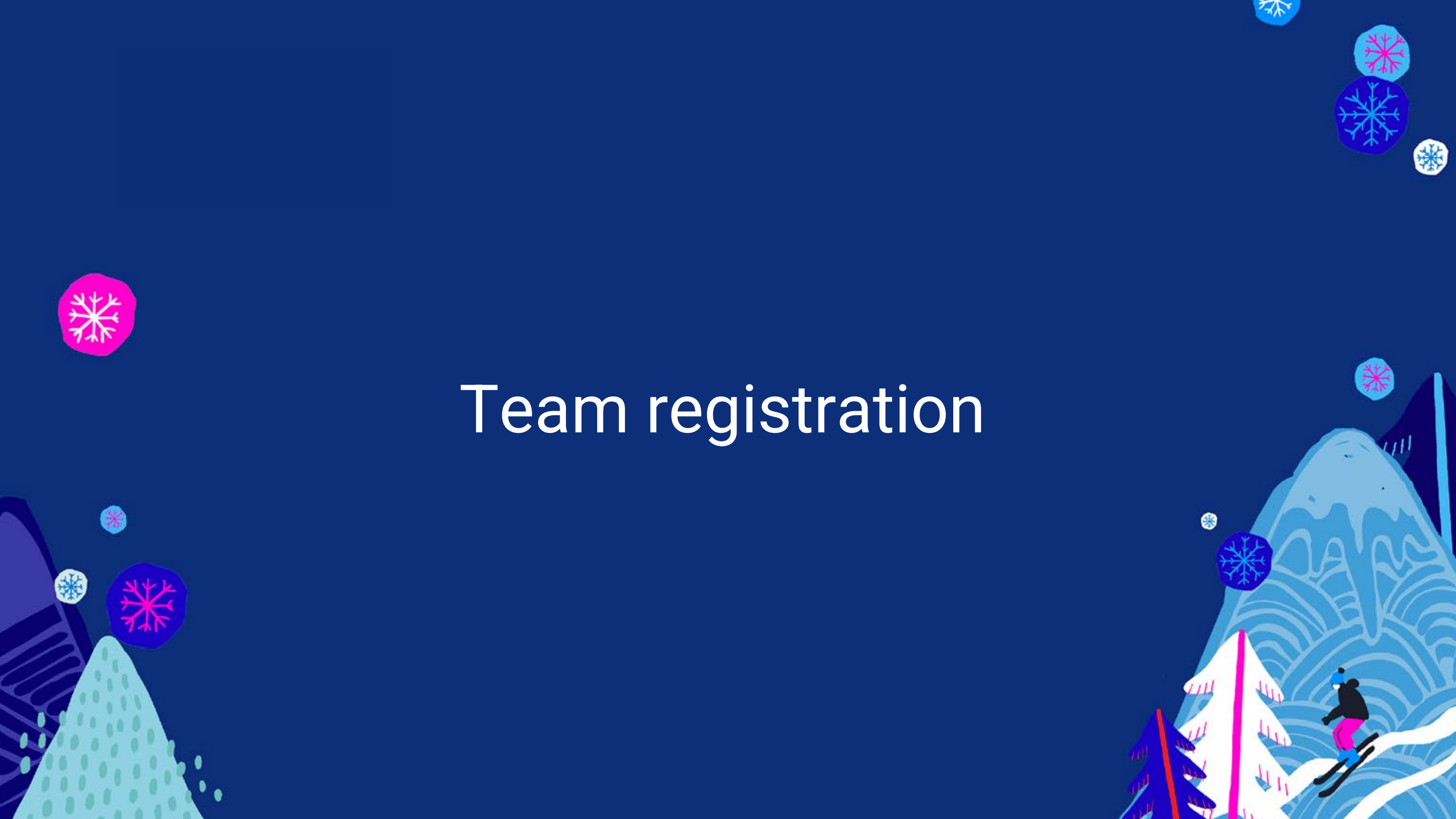
Site map – Ski and alpine touring trails

Before departure: Leave your skis and poles **on the rack near the gondola** (a volunteer will guide you)

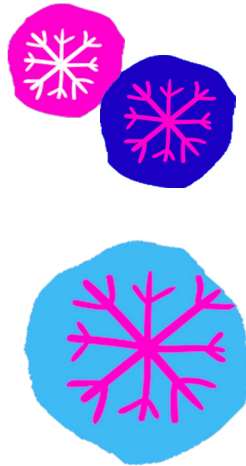

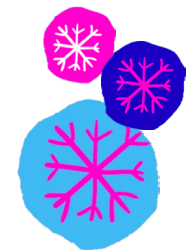


First round procedure

- 1 participant per team takes part in the start parade;
- The starting participant must wear his bib and chip;
- The parade will go up Rue des Remparts towards the base of the mountain;
- The timed sports challenge will begin at the entrance of your respective courses.

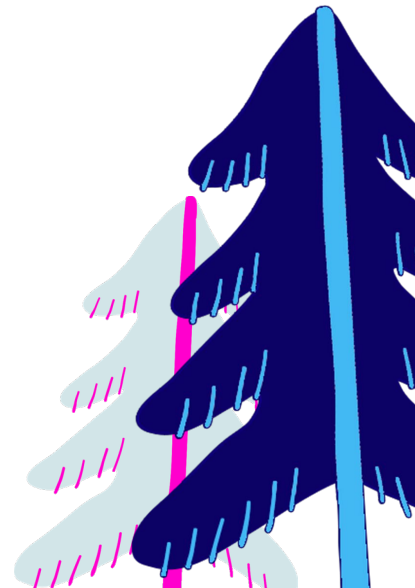
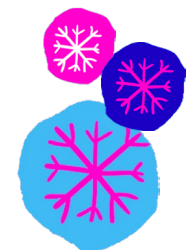
- Teammates who wish to **join** the participant who took part in the parade for the first lap must **wait at the Place des Voyageurs**.
- The Cabriolet is an integral part of the course, both uphill and downhill, even if you do more than one lap during your relay.



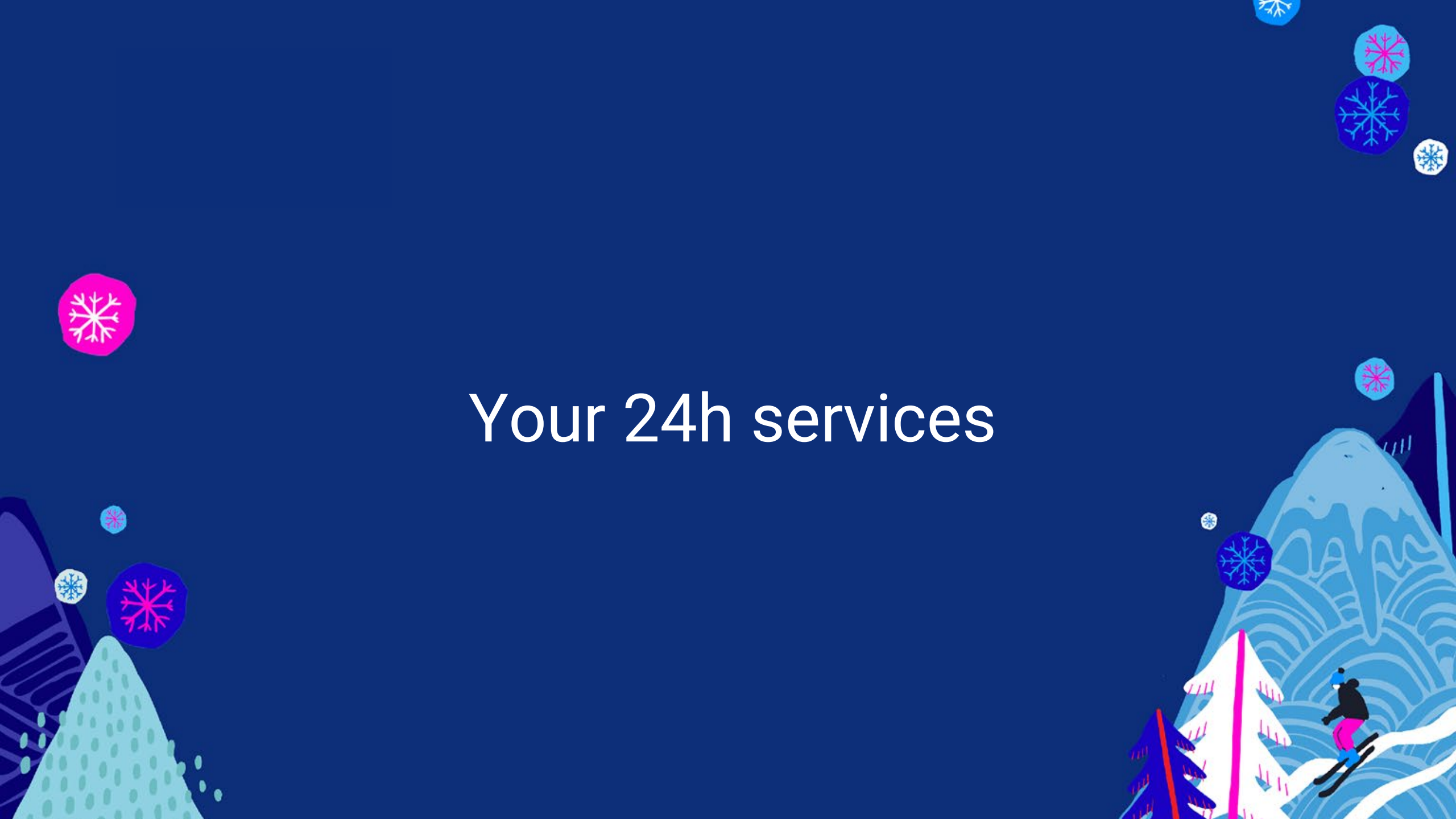
